DISCUSSION

The County Board of Education will discuss the nomination of the HERO Project for a Golden Bell Award in the category of “Parental/Community Involvement.” The deadline for entries is June 26, 2015. The criteria used to evaluate the nominations include:

- Is data driven
- Has made a difference for students
- Is innovative or exemplary
- Is connected to the Board's vision and is supported by the Board
- Shows evidence of Board support and leadership
- Is sustainable over time
- Concepts can be replicated

Awards will be presented on December 5, at the CSBA Annual Conference.

One of the disqualifying criteria is “the program has not been in operation for at least two school years.” Staff will need to determine if the developmental year(s) can be included as an operational year.

FISCAL, STAFFING AND FACILITIES ISSUES

The fiscal impact will be limited to the cost of attending the conference for 3 to 6 employees and/or board members.

Preparation of the application and supporting documentation will impact staff time and may require temporary secretarial support.
