**Designate Membership to the North Central Adult Education Consortium
Executive Committee (NCAEC)**

ISSUE

To authorize Brock Falkenberg as a member of the North Central Adult Education Consortium Executive Committee

BACKGROUND/PREVIOUS BOARD ACTIVITY

The Legislature retained most of the provisions regarding adult education (formerly referred to as AB 86) in the Governor's May Revise budget proposal and AB 104 was signed by the Governor. AB 104 includes the Adult Education Block Grant (AEBG) program. In order to receive funds from the Block Grant, a member must be a part of a regional consortium. Entities eligible for funding from the Block Grant include school districts, county offices of education, community college districts, and joint powers authorities. The AEBG requires that any member of a consortium be officially designated by the governing board of the member.

DISCUSSION

Per AB 104 Consortium Governance guidelines, any community college district, school district, joint power, or county office of education located within the boundaries of the adult education region shall be permitted to join the consortium as a member. Each member's governance board shall designate an "official" to the consortium. Executive Committee members are to have the institutional authority to set consortium policy and make budget disbursement decisions. NCAEC supports as appropriate the designation of the Superintendent of the Sutter County Superintendent of Schools Office.
