**RESOLUTION NO. 1516-04**

***Education Code Section 60119***

**RESOLUTION REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR  
RENAISSANCE COURT SCHOOL**

**Whereas**, the Governing Board of the Lake County Office of Education, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on August 19, 2015, at 5:00 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the end of the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

**Whereas**, the Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing by posting it in at least three public places within the district stating the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

**Whereas**, the Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

**Whereas**, information provided at the public hearing detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Lake County Office of Education, and;

**Whereas**, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including English learners, has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

**Whereas**, between the 2008-09 through the 2015-16 fiscal years, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Lake County Office of Education, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle, and;

**Whereas**, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:
